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Machine Applique 101

Level: All

Conquer the dreaded “A” word and learn how to do raw-edge applique. Fusible Heat n’ Bond Lite and 5 easy finishing techniques make applique fast, easy, and fun! Atkinson Designs’ “Triplets” pattern (Fish option) works up quickly with just the right number of fish to learn five raw-edge finishes: straight stitch, zigzag, blanket stitch, blind hem, and satin stitch. “Applique” will no longer be a forbidden word!

Supplies:

- “Triplets” quilt pattern by Atkinson Designs
- Sewing machine in good working order
- 75/11 quilting or 80/12 Microtex machine needles
- ¼” foot & clear or open-toe applique foot
- 50 wt. cotton thread to match or contrast with assorted print fabrics
- 6½” x 24” ruler
- Creative Grids Round-Up tool CGRATK1
- Rotary cutter
- Fabrics – per the pattern, for the Fish option
 - 2¼ yards Main Fabric
 - (4) 6” x 21” prints for fish
 - 1¼ yards Heat n’ Bond Lite
- Cutting mat, pins, scissors, seam ripper
- Best Press

Pre-Class:

- Read pages 3 & 4 of the pattern.
- Cut fabrics per top of page 3:
 - Print fabrics: Cut 1 strip 6” x 21” from each of the 4 prints.
 - Main color fabric: Cut 4 strips 7” x width of fabric.
Spray with Best Press and iron to stabilize.
Subcut (14) 7” x 10” rectangles and (2) 6” x 5” rectangles.
 - Fusible: Cut 4 strips 5½” x 20½”.
